Before You Get Started, Did You Know?...

Although Direct Sale Vendors won't tell you, you can sell your Kindle and ePub formatted ebooks directly to buyers from your website and they can sync them with their device.

That's right. You can sell your ebooks from your website or blog, and your customers can transfer them directly to their device without buying through Direct Sale Vendors (Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Apple). It's a great way to add more revenue to your bottom line.

Testing Your Ebook

If you don't own a Kindle to test your ebook we recommend downloading the Kindle Reader Application for Mac or PC. This will give you an idea of how your Kindle ebook will look within the Kindle interface.

Once installed you can set your local content file and copy the file attached to this directory and read your ebook.

Files We Provide

When we convert and format your manuscript for Kindle we'll provide you the following formats:

- .prc
- .mobi
- .azw

The .prc and .mobi formats were originally designed for earlier versions of the Kindle device. We suggest using the .azw format as it will work with all Kindle devices.

Once you have configured your account you'll be able to upload your ebook and release it to the marketplace.

ISBN Numbers can only be purchased through the following vendor. <http://www.isbn.org/standards/home/index.asp>. The ISBN number that you purchase for the iTunes Connect Platform will be used for the Barnes & Noble Pubit Platform too. You do not need all of the additional services they will try to sell you through the sales process, just the ISBN Number.
